1. Grievance of the petitioner is that point-wise reply stated to have been given to the petitioner in response to his RTI application dated 29.08.2019 by post vide letter dated 03.10.2019, was never received by him and that despite filing a rejoinder in the second appeal vide Annexure P/6, no action has been taken to supply a copy of letter dated 03.10.2019 as referred to in paragraph No.2 of order Annexure P/5 dated 04.12.2019. Learned counsel states that the petitioner would be satisfied if the writ petition is disposed of at this stage by directing the State Information Commission, Haryana, to ensure that copy of communication dated 03.10.2019 as referred to in paragraph No.2 of order Annexure P/5 dated 04.12.2019 is supplied to the petitioner.

2. Notice of motion to respondent No.3 only. Mr. Harish Rathee, Sr. DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.3 and waives service. Learned Sr. DAG states that he has no objection if the writ petition is disposed of by giving time bound

directions to respondent No.3 to furnish a copy of letter dated 03.10.2019 as is referred to in paragraph No.2 of Annexure P/5 dated 04.12.2019.

3. In the light of the position as noted above, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.3 to furnish a copy of letter dated 03.10.2019 as is referred in paragraph No.2 of Annexure P/5 dated 04.12.2019, to the petitioner within one week from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
