The instant Petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking Regular Bail in case FIR No.360, dated 28.10.2019, registered under Section 17 of the NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Civil Line Sirsa, District Sirsa.

2. The Petitioner has remained in detention in this case for more than 1½ months.

3. No recovery was effected from the present Petitioner and his name was transpired from the Disclosure Statement of co-accused, namely, Rameshwar. The recovery in this case even from Rameshwar was of below the commercial quantity.

4. The Petitioner is alleged to have been subsequently apprehended with Opium weighing 280 grams in connection with the different FIR. In either case, no recovery of commercial quantity is involved.

5. For the aforesaid reasons, the present Petition is allowed and the Petitioner, namely, Pritam Singh @ Raju, is ordered to be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court concerned.
