Petition is for quashing of FIR No.582 dated 13.10.2018 (Annexure P1) under Sections 341, 506, 427, 34 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act 1959, registered at Police Station Sonapat Sadar, District Sonapat.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 submits that there is no compromise between the parties and rather some more FIRs have been registered *inter-se* parties.

In view of the above, quashing of the FIR Annexure P1 on the basis of compromise cannot proceed.
