The petitioner has approached this Court seeking issuance of directions to the official respondents No.2 and 3 not to harass and humiliate the petitioner by implicating or involving him in any FIR falsely.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and while refraining from making any expression as regards the veracity of the averments made in the petition, the petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, District Sri Muktsar Sahib (respondent No.2) to ensure that in case the petitioner who is a lady is required to be associated with any inquiry or any information is to be elicited from her in respect of some dishonour of cheque, then a prior notice be afforded to the

petitioner. It is however, clarified that the aforesaid direction is not to be construed as any kind of absolute bar against registration of FIR in case it is found that some offence has been committed by the petitioner or for conducting any proceedings in accordance with law.

A copy of this order be sent to Senior Superintendent of Police, District Sri Muktsar Sahib (respondent No.2), so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
