This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Nakodar District Jalandhar to dispose of FIR No.62 dated 02.05.2014 under Sections 392, 482, 420, 467, 468, 471, 411 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Mehatpur, District Jalandhar (Rural).

It is pointed out by the counsel for the petitioner that the aforesaid FIR was registered way back in the year 2014 and out of total 20 witnesses only 07 witnesses have been examined till today.
