Prayer in this writ petition is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to consider and decide application dated 06.01.2020 (Annexure P-3), moved by the petitioner before the Deputy Commissioner, Moga.

It is submitted that due to a matrimonial dispute, the petitioner came to know that his wife is taking action for cancellation of his Arms license. The petitioner, it is further submitted, seeks hearing from the concerned authority before cancellation.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

Apart from the fact that this writ petition is clearly premature, there is nothing on record to indicate that any such application for cancellation of the Arms license has indeed been moved. Moreover, the prayer made in representation dated 06.01.2020 (Annexure P-3), reads as

under:-

“Therefore, through this application, you are requested to protect me from the abovesaid persons. If anything happens to me, my in-laws family will be responsible for the same as they are threatening me to kill me and to lodge false and frivolous complaints against me.

I shall be highly thankful to you.”

Needless to say, in case, the petitioner, moves an appropriate application before the Deputy Commissioner, Moga, in respect to the prayer made in this writ petition, the same be looked into and appropriate action, if any, be taken in accordance with law.

Writ petition is accordingly disposed of.
