Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Custody certificate by way of affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent, Central Jail, Amritsar, has been filed through e-mail. Print out of the same is taken on record.

Through this second petition, the petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.68 dated 10.08.2018, registered at Police Station Valtoha, District Tarn Taran, under Sections 21 and 22 NDPS Act, read with Sections 473, 379 and 411 IPC (added subsequently vide rapat No.20 dated 28.01.2019).

As per the prosecution version, 2000 tablets of Tramadol were allegedly recovered from the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case; that challan has been presented and that the petitioner has been in custody since 10.08.2018.

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On the other hand, learned State counsel opposes the prayer made in the present petition.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

The recovery effected in the present case falls under commercial quantity. However while poring the custody certificate, it is axiomatic that the petitioner has as many as three other cases registered against him under the NDPS Act and out of them, he was convicted in one case.

Keeping in view the fact that recovery effected in the present case falls under commercial quantity coupled with the fact that he is involved in three other cases under the NDPS Act, this Court finds that the petitioner is not entitled for the benefit of the regular bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
