Petitioner applied for the post of Assistant Blcok Resource Coordinator under the Haryana School Shiksha Parishad. As part of the selection process petitioner participated in an examination conducted on 17.8.2019. Result thereof was declared on 10.9.2019.

Grievance raised in the petition is that after declaration of result, the candidates who fell within the zone of consideration were given the chance to opt for a choice of station/posting on 11.9.2019 but since the server of the official respondents was down, such option could not be exercised by the petitioner. Mandamus is now being sought for the petitioner to be adjusted at certain vacant stations close to Fatehabad which is the home town of the petitioner.

Having heard counsel at length, this Court is of the considered view that no interference is warranted.

Even if it was to be accepted that the server of the department was down on 11.9.2019 the petitioner ought to have agitated the matter immediately thereafter. Rather pleadings on record would show that petitioner was allotted Ambala station which he had joined on 14.9.2019

itself. The delay in having approached the Writ Court is sought to be

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justified on the ground that petitioner had certain financial constraints. This Court does not consider the same to justify filing of the instant writ petition after a time period elapse of five months.

Dismissed.
