The case is taken up through video conferencing on account of COVID 2019.

Quashing of FIR No. 74 dated 27.7.2018 registered under Sections 420, 120 B IPC at Police Station Mehna, District Moga and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise has been sought.

Vide order dated 18.3.2019, parties were directed to appear before learned trial Court/Area Judicial Magistrate on 26.4.2019 for recording their statements and trial Court was to send its report regarding the genuineness of compromise.

Report of learned JMJC, Moga is received wherein it is stated that compromise effected between the parties is genuine and voluntary in nature.

In view thereof, this petition is allowed. FIR No. 74 dated 27.7.2018 registered under Sections 420, 120 B IPC at Police Station Mehna, District Moga and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.
