Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.238 dated 01.11.2018, registered under Sections 15/25/61/85 of the Narcotics Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act at Police Station Sangat, District Bathinda.

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Iqbal submitted that out of 24 prosecution witnesses, 22 witnesses have already been examined. Now 2 witnesses are left and 10.02.2020 is the next date before the trial Court.

Recovery effected from the petitioner is commercial in

nature. The trial is at the fag end and there is every likelihood of its culmination either on the date fixed or soon thereafter.

In view of above, there is no ground to grant regular bail to the petitioner. This petition is accordingly dismissed.
