ARUN MONGA, J.

1. Applicant-wife is seeking transfer of petition filed by respondent-husband under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act against her for dissolution of marriage, pending in the Court of District Judge (Additional Family Court), Hisar to the competent Court in District Jind.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that destitute wife is residing in the jurisdiction of District Jind and has also filed a petition under Section 12 of the Domestic Violence Act in the Court of Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Narwana, in which respondent has put in appearance and is contesting the same. According to learned counsel, it is not possible for the wife, who has no income, to travel to Hisar to contest the divorce petition filed by the husband.

3. It would, therefore, be just and proper if the petition filed under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act is also transferred to competent Court at Jind. In the premise, instant petition is allowed. The petition is question is withdrawn from the Court of District Judge(Additional Family Court) and is transferred to the competent Court at Jind.

4. The records of the case be sent forthwith to the District Judge, Jind for its assignment to competent Court for disposal, in accordance with law.
