Prayer in the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution read with Section 482 Cr.P.C., is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus directing respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to get released the detenue, namely Suriya @ Simran Kaur, wife of the petitioner, immediately from the illegal confinement of respondent Nos. 4 to 8 and further to appoint Warrant Officer for the said purpose.

Vide order dated 07.02.2020 passed by this Court, Warrant Officer was appointed to record the statement of detenue-Suriya @ Simran Kaur by taking assistance of the concerned SHO.

In compliance thereof, the Warrant Officer, vide report dated 13.02.2020, has submitted that when he along with petitioner reached to the parental house of the detenue, hue and cry was raised by the mother, father and other relatives of the detenue. On the asking of the Warrant Officer from

the detainee whether she has been detained there, she stated that she has married to petitioner-Gurdev Singh of her own and wants to live with him.

Today the petitioner as well as detainee-Suriya @ Simran Kaur are present in Court, who have been identified by Mr. K.S. Sandhu, Advocate. The detainee states that she has married with petitioner on 02.12.2018 and wants to live with him as husband and wife.

In view of the above, no further orders are called for in the present petition.

Disposed of accordingly.
