The instant Petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking Regular Bail in case FIR No.70, dated 21.04.2017, registered under Sections 399, 402 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and under Sections 25, 27, 54 and 59 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Division No.7, Jalandhar, Punjab.

2. The Petitioner was originally granted bail by the Ld. Court below itself. He, however, absented from the proceedings on 13th February, 2019, on account of which, his bail was cancelled and coercive processes against him, were issued.

3. The Petitioner was arrested on 6th November, 2019. His explanation in this regard is that being a resident of a different District

(Gurdaspur), he could not appear before the Ld. Trial Court in Jalandhar, as a wrong date had been noted and communicated to him.

4. Be that as it may, in view of the long detention undergone by the present Petitioner after his re-arrest, at this stage, he is ordered to be released on a fresh bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court concerned subject to imposition of appropriate stringent conditions as thought fit and proper.
