The petitioners have approached this Court seeking issuance of direction to respondents No.1 and 2 to protect their lives and liberty as they apprehend threat to the same at the hands of respondents No.3 to 9.

Petitioner No.1 is already married to respondent No.6 and the said marriage is still subsisting, but she is stated to have left her matrimonial home as she was being ill-treated by her husband.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that after petitioner No.1 left her matrimonial home, petitioner No.2 extended support to her in her difficult times and petitioner No.1 has been residing with petitioner No.2 as her friend but the private respondents are bent upon causing harm to the petitioners.

While refraining from making any expression as regards the veracity of the averments made in the petition, the petition is disposed of

with a direction that in case the petitioners approach the police authorities concerned by way of filing a detailed representation with regard to their alleged threat perception, the same shall be got examined by Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala (respondent No.2), expeditiously in accordance with law and necessary steps as may be warranted under the facts and circumstances of the case be taken thereupon forthwith.

A copy of this order be sent to Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala (respondent No.2), so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
