Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.440 dated 11.12.2017 under Sections 386, 506, 34 IPC, Section 25/54/59 of Arms Act and Sections 364-A, 395, 201 IPC (added later on), registered at Police Station Sector-36, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for U.T. Chandigarh submits that there are serious allegations against the petitioner and Scorpio car of the complainant was never recovered throughout the proceedings. Learned counsel for U.T. Chandigarh, on instructions from ASI Ashok Kumar, further submits that the entire prosecution evidence is concluded and the case is now fixed for recording the defence evidence.

In view of the above, I find no ground to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner. However, the trial Court is directed to conclude the trial expeditiously preferably within a period of four months from today.

Disposed of, accordingly.
