CRM-M-6138-2020

Through this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks regular bail in case bearing FIR No.260 dated 09.10.2019 registered under Sections 307,323,506,148,149 IPC and Sections 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station Moti Nagar, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that though the injuries attributed to the petitioner are not on the vital part yet a compromise has been effected between the complainant, injured and the petitioner. In support of such assertion, the learned counsel for the petitioner has placed reliance on the affidavit dated 04.09.2020 of the complainant Gurpreet Singh alias Goldy along with affidavits of injured Taranjit Singh and Gaurav both dated 04.09.2020, which is placed on record in the connected case bearing No. CRM-M-12603-2020.

At this stage, learned State counsel on the instructions from

ASI Dhanwat Singh, assisted by learned counsel for the complainant, does not dispute the factum of the compromise between the parties.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner has been in custody since 14.10.2019. Trial of the case would take time to conclude. Therefore, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits, lest it should prejudice the case of either side, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
