GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioners have approached this Court seeking quashing of criminal Complaint No.1483, dated 17.12.2013, titled Deepak Walia and others Vs. Dr. Raj Pal and others, under Sections 420, 406, 409, 467, 468, 471, 472, 506, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and summoning order dated 15.3.2017 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Kaithal and all subsequent proceedings

emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise effected between the parties.

2. Vide order dated 14.2.2019, the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.
3. Report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Kaithal, has been received, wherein it has been reported that statements of petitioners/accused Satyapal Choudhary, Dr. Rajpal and also of complainants Deepak Walia, Deepak Kumar, Ravi Kumar, Vikram have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves.
4. The complainants in their statements have specifically stated that they have no objection in case the criminal complaint and summoning order in question is quashed.
5. The learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Kaithal, has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.
6. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and criminal Complaint No.1483, dated 17.12.2013, titled as Deepak Walia and others Vs. Dr. Raj Pal and others, under Sections 420, 406, 409, 467, 468, 471, 472, 506, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and summoning order dated 15.3.2017 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Kaithal and all subsequent

proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
