The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case FIR No.172 dated 04.11.2019, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 506 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Sadar Patti, District Tarn Taran.

[2]. Ld. Counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners have remained in detention for more than 3 months now, since 17.02.2020. In the meantime, investigation against them has since been completed and challan submitted.

[3]. Ld. State counsel does not dispute the above facts.

[4]. In view of the above, further detention of the petitioners for an indefinite period at this stage is not warranted and they are ordered to be released on regular bail, subject to the appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
