This is a petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and their family members at the hands of respondents No.5 to 15.

Learned counsel for petitioners contended that petitioners have already made representation dated 08.02.2020 to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/6, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Harbir Sandhu, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Complete copy of paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Fazilka, to look into and decide representation dated 08.02.2020 (Annexure P/6) as expeditiously as possible and that too in accordance with law.
