ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.532 dated 29.09.2019, under Sections 302/452 and 34 IPC (Annexure P-1/T), registered at Police Station Ambala Cantt, District Ambala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner, who was unarmed, along with the co-accused, had caught hold of the deceased and given him slaps and fist blows. He further contends that the petitioner is the mother of the main accused, who is alleged to have hit the deceased with an iron brazier. He also contends that the petitioner is over 60 years of age and is suffering from various ailments including diabetes. He has referred to the order of the Additional Sessions Judge dated 07.08.2020 wherein it is mentioned that the petitioner is under treatment and is being medically examined at the Civil Hospital, Ambala and provided with the prescribed medicine. The petitioner is in custody for over a year since her arrest on 30.09.2019.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Mukesh Kumar, contends that 3 out of 15 prosecution witnesses have been examined. The petitioner is in custody since her arrest on 30.09.2019.

Heard through video conferencing.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when the petitioner is a 60 years old lady, she is in custody for over a year, she is suffering from various ailments including diabetes, the COVID-19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on her furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
