Mr. Rajiv Goel, DAG Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and has no objection in case the application is allowed.

Accordingly, application is allowed and Annexures P-3 to P-7 are taken on record.

Crl. Misc. No. M-7247 of 2020

The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 0135 dated 02.07.2019 registered under Sections 34, 379-B IPC at Police Station Uchana, District Jind.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in custody for more than one year and the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date as only 7 PWs out of a total of 16 PWs have been examined till date. False implication can not be ruled out as the petitioner was arrested in this case on the basis of disclosure statement suffered by him in another case. Thus, the

petitioner may be granted regular bail.

Custody certificate dated 30.07.2020 of Deputy Superintendent, District Prison, Jind has been placed on record. According to this custody certificate, the petitioner has undergone actual custody of 1 year and 24 days. There are three other criminal cases pending against him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has been granted regular bail in all the other pending cases.

It is, thus, apparent that the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date and that the petitioner has been in custody for more than one year. Keeping in view the custody period as well as the stage of the trial, I deem it appropriate to grant bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
