Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 09 dated 21.01.2020 registered under Section 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, at Police Station Barnala, District Barnala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the present FIR has been registered on the application of Ajay Kumar-Branch Manager, SBI, SBOP, Handiaya and the petitioner has only identified the main accused-Amardeep Singh as Arjun Singh who has taken loan of Rs. 12 lakhs.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has also argued that the allegation of impersonation, forgery and representation of forged and fabricated documents are against Amardeep Singh, *Nambardar*-Ram Singh, witness-Sunil Kumar, deed writer-Vipin Singh and *Halqa Patwari*-Navdeep Singh.

After perusal of the complaint and order dated 04.02.2020 passed by Additional Sessions Judge, Barnala, whereby the bail application of the petitioner was dismissed, it is observed that on the identification of the petitioner, Amardeep Singh managed to obtain loan of Rs. 12 lakhs on the basis of forged and fabricated documents.

In view of the above, no ground is made out to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed accordingly.
