The petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. challenging the order dated 21.1.2020 (Annexure P-8), passed by Chief Judicial Magistrate, Hoshiarpur, whereby the charges under Section 420 and 120-B IPC were framed against them in a complaint case bearing No.COMI/253/8.8.2014.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed by the learned counsel for the petitioners that the trial is at an advanced stage, as the trial Court is proceeding with recording of after-charge evidence wherein the complainant has been again recalled for cross-examination at the instance of the petitioners. Therefore, he does not press this petition at this stage and wishes to withdraw the same with liberty to raise all these issues before the trial Court at an appropriate stage.

It is further prayed that the petitioners who are residents of United Kingdom be allowed to go abroad, as they are in India for the

purpose of present trial only.

The second prayer for permission to go abroad can be made by the petitioners before the trial Court and in case any such application is filed, the same be decided expeditiously.

Petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as prayed for.
