The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a criminal writ in the nature of mandamus seeking directions to respondent No.3 to release the petitioner on parole for meeting his family members and to take care of their needs and further to issue a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the order dated 04.01.2020 passed by District Magistrate, Rai Bareilly, Uttar Pradesh to Inspector General of Prisons, Chandigarh, whereby parole to the petitioner to meet his family members has been declined.

It is contended that the petitioner was earlier released on parole and he did not misuse the said concession. The petitioner had surrendered back before the jail authorities one day prior to the date of surrendering.

Heard.

The petitioner has earlier not misused the concession of parole and particularly in this view of the matter, he is entitled to be released on parole. In the circumstances, this Court is inclined to allow this petition. Ordered accordingly.

The petitioner is ordered to be released on parole for a period of 28 days from the date of his release as per Rules on furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of the District Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Panipat. The petitioner shall surrender before the jail authorities after expiry of 28 days and date of surrender to be noticed by the releasing Court.
