Learned Addl. Public Prosecutor, Chandigarh has placed on record status report wherein it has been mentioned that the marriage of Sumitra Devi @ Jaspreet Kaur was solemnized with petitioner No.1 on 28.12.2006 and petitioner No.2 was born from the wedlock. The petitioner No.1 started misbehaving and quarrelling with her on the petty issues and she left the matrimonial house of her own free will and is presently residing with her parents and elder brother namely Thakur Daas. She also made a statement to the effect that she is residing of her own free will and no one had detained or forced her to stay at her parental house and she is not having any apprehension of danger from anyone. She has also stated that she does not want to return back to her matrimonial house.

Faced with this situation, it has been stated by learned counsel for the petitioners that the petition be dismissed as withdrawn.
