Petitioners have filed this petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty from the hands of respondent Nos.5 to 8 and not to harass them on any false complaint.

On 13.02.2020, learned State counsel was directed to find out the existence of alleged threat. In response to the said order, separate affidavits of the petitioners have been filed in Court today, wherein it is mentioned that they are living happily as husband and wife.

In view of the above, nothing survives for adjudication in this petition, which is rendered infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.
