This is an appeal that has been filed as far back as 2016. A reading of the *zimni* orders would reflect that learned counsel for the appellant has not addressed arguments as to why the judgment under appeal deserves to be set aside. In fact the matter was dismissed for non-prosecution by an order dated 18.04.2017 and consequently, on an application moved by learned counsel, it was restored to the original number.

This Court, vide an order dated 13.08.2018 had granted last opportunity to address arguments. The matter was again adjourned on the request of learned counsel for the appellant on the subsequent hearing. Four years have lapsed since the filing of the appeal but as on date, no arguments

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had been addressed.

The matter has been called twice and no one has appeared on behalf of the appellant even today.

Consequently, the appeal stands dismissed for want of prosecution.
