The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking a direction to the official respondents to conduct the investigation in a fair and impartial manner as well as to register a case against the private respondents.

At this stage, counsel for the petitioner limits his prayer to the extent that the representation (Annexure P-3) of the petitioner should be decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

At this stage, on the asking of the court, Mr. Davinder Bir Singh, DAG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that official respondents will look into the matter and will decide the representation of the petitioner. Let sufficient number of copies of the

paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day, failing which no action is called for.

In view of the above, I dispose of the instant petition by directing the respondents to decide the representation (Annexure P-3) of the petitioner within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.

The petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
