Prayer in the petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for the issuance of a writ of Mandamus for directing respondent No.2 to take a decision on Legal Notice Annexure P-4 dated 08.01.2020 and to regularize the services of the petitioner on the post of Tractor driver.

Notice of motion to respondent No.2 only.

Mr. Harish Rathee, Sr.DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2, waives service and states that he has no objection to the limited prayer of the petitioner.

Without commenting upon the merits of the controversy or the entitlement of the petitioner to the relief claimed, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the claim made in the Legal Notice Annexure P-4 dated 08.01.2020 in accordance with law after taking into account all aspects of the matter as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
