Learned counsel states that the petitioner appeared in a departmental examination for promotion to the post of Accountant and qualified four out of six papers though securing minimum percentage of marks for promotion i.e. 45% and although relaxation was granted vide Annexure P/4 to two candidates in minimum percentage of marks required for promotion and to one candidate in passing requisite numbers of papers as well as percentage required for promotion, the petitioner was not granted relaxation. Learned counsel contends that in the circumstances the petitioner is also entitled to grant of relaxation in qualifying the number of papers requisite for promotion. Learned counsel further stated that the petitioner has submitted representation Annexure P/5 dated 30.09.2019, in respect of the grievance which is the subject matter of the writ petition but the same has not been decided till date and in the circumstances the petitioner would be satisfied if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2

to consider and decide the same, in accordance with law in a time bound manner.

2. Notice of motion to respondent No.2 only. Mr. Harish Rathee, learned Sr. DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2 and states that he has no objection to the limited prayer of learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. Without commenting upon the merits of the controversy or the entitlement of the petitioner to the relief claimed, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide representation Annexure P/5 dated 30.09.2019, in accordance with law after taking into account all aspects of the matter, as expeditiously as possible.
