This is second petition for grant of bail in a criminal case arising from FIR No. 94 dated 13.6.2019 registered under Sections 21, 22 NDPS Act, 1985, at Police Station Sadar Nabha, District Patiala.

First petition was dismissed on 13.11.2019. Learned counsel for the petitioner failed to draw attention of the Court to any new fact or ground to enlarge the petitioner on bail. Recovery from the petitioner is of commercial quantity. Section 37 of the NDPS Act lays down stringent provision for grant of bail. Petitioner is involved in another case vide FIR No.20/2019 registered under Sections 21,61,85 NDPS Act, Police Station Sadar Nabha.

In view thereof, no ground to grant bail to the petitioner is made out.
