Challenge in this writ petition is to the termination order dated 30.07.2011(Annexure P-4) passed by the Deputy Director, Administration-III on behalf of the Director, Industrial Training, Haryana.

Perusal of the said order reflects that the due procedure was followed before terminating the services of the petitioner. No explanation is forthcoming from the petitioner as to why he did not choose to challenge the aforesaid order at the relevant point of time. Though the petitioner claims to have made representations, no effective steps were taken by him if he had any grievance with regard to his removal from service.

Further, it is also significant note that the petitioner filed CWP No.5771 of 2016 before this Court in relation to his terminal benefits. By

order dated 29.03.2016 this Court disposed of the said writ petition, directing the authorities to take appropriate action upon the petitioner’s representation on the issue. Had the petitioner any grievance with regard to his termination from service, he ought to have laid a challenge to the same at least when he filed the earlier writ petition. Having failed to do so, it is not open to the petitioner to now assail the termination order of 2011. The petition is hit incurable delay and laches and is accordingly dismissed on that short ground.
