MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J.

Present petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the impugned judgment and decree dated 31.08.2018 passed by learned Additional District Judge, Gurugram, whereby a bunch of appeals including the appeals filed against the present petitioners were allowed and the judgment and decree dated 16.04.2018 of learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Gurugram, were set aside.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners has pointed out that controversy in the present case is fully covered by an order dated 20.11.2019; whereby bunch of revisions along with connected Regular Second Appeals were allowed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court and the matter was remanded back to learned lower Appellate Court for fresh decision.

Copy of the order dated 20.11.2019 produced in Court and the same is taken on record as Mark 'X'.

Registry to tag the same at the appropriate place.

On the other hand, learned counsel for respondent No.2- Municipal Corporation, fairly acknowledged that the controversy in

the present case is squarely covered with the above order dated 20.11.2019 and he has no objection, in case this petition is disposed off in the same terms.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, present petition is disposed off in the same terms as order dated 20.11.2019 passed in bunch of other case(s).

Parties shall appear before the learned lower Appellate Court on the date already fixed in the connected matters.
