GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

Petitioner-Raj Pal Inspector No.HAP/81, has filed the present writ petition *inter alia* praying for direction to the respondents to consider and grant the benefit of one annual increment.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has completed one full year of service w.e.f. 01.07.2018 to 30.06.2019 in view of the law settled by judgment dated 15.09.2017 (Annexure P-3), passed by the Hon'ble Madras High Court, which was upheld by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India vide judgment dated 23.07.2018 (Annexure P-4).

At this stage, learned counsel submits that for the above demand, the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 14.11.2019 (Annexure P-2) to respondent No.3. He submits that he be satisfied, in case a time bound direction is given to the authorities to examine the said representation in view of the judgments as aforementioned.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Palika Monga, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

Accordingly, this writ petition is **disposed of** with a direction to respondent No.3 to examine the matter and decide the representation in accordance with law within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
