Petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to conduct a fair and impartial investigation in FIR No.0051 dated 06.04.2017 under Sections 354-B, 506 IPC(Annexure P-1) and under Sections 376, 511, 506, 323, 452 IPC as per GDR(Annexure P-2), registered at Police Station Majitha, Amritsar.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Mukhtiar Singh, states that after filing of the present petition, respondent No.4- Prabhjot Singh @ Prabhjeet Singh @ Prabha has been arrested in the case and during the course of investigation, offences under Sections 376, 511

IPC have not been found established.

In view of the above, so far as prayer of the petitioner to have fair and impartial investigation in the case is concerned, nothing survives in the present petition and the same is rendered infructuous.
