This petition has been filed seeking a direction to the official respondents to take action on the petitioner's representation dated 11.02.2020 (Annexure P7) whereby it is stated that respondent No. 6 should not be permitted to hold any tournament/cultural programme involving the use of loudspeaker etc. during the Board examination of the children starting from 15.02.2020. It is stated that the school is existing within 350 metres of the premises on which the tournament/cultural programme is to be held. It is noticed that prima facie, this petition is not maintainable at the instance of the petitioner. The concerned school or the allegedly affected students are not before this Court.

However, at this stage, learned counsel for the State, on telephonic instructions from Mr. J.S. Johal, SDM, Nawanshahr submits that no such permission to use loudspeaker etc. during the Board examination of the children has been sought by any entity nor granted and furthermore, no such permission to use loudspeakers shall, in any case, be granted during this period on the premises as alleged. It is further submitted that the authorities are bound to comply with the directions of this Court in CWP

No. 6213 of 2016 (Reet Mohinder Singh versus State of Punjab and others).

In this view of the matter, no orders are called for in this petition. It is clarified that there is no expression of opinion on the maintainability of this petition at the instance of the present petitioner.

Accordingly, petition is disposed of.
