Learned counsel for the petitioner prays that though the Chief Engineer has already granted the required benefits to the petitioner but as those benefits were not being extended, as being claimed in the writ petition, petitioner served a legal notice upon the respondents for the grant of benefits. Learned counsel states that Executive Engineer has replied to the legal notice declining the claim though, his superior authority had already accepted the claim of the petitioner, therefore, the reply given by the Executive Engineer is contrary to the stand taken by the Chief Engineer.

On being pointed out as to why the petitioner has not approached the superior authority bringing to his notice the reply/stand of the Executive Engineer, learned counsel for the petitioner prays that he be allowed to withdraw this writ petition, at this stage, with liberty to approach the Chief Engineer bringing to his notice the relevant facts for seeking the relief of grant of time bound pay scale on the post of Junior Engineer.

Dismissed as withdrawn, with the liberty, as prayed for.
