Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the Marriage Certificate, Annexure P-3 which was placed along with the petition is not correctly typed. He has filed in court a correct typed copy of the Marriage Certificate. Same is taken on record as Annexure P-3 in place of Annexure P-3 already filed with the petition.

Avni Sharma and Abhishek Sharma, the petitioners before this Court, claim themselves to be major. They have pleaded that they have married against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 8 and seek protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from respondents No.4 to 8. They have placed on record marriage certificate and photographs, Annexures P-3 and P-4 respectively, evidencing their marriage. The petitioners have submitted a representation, Annexure P-7 to the Commissioner of Police, Gurgaon.

Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, this petition is disposed of

with direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation of the petitioners, Annexure P-7 and grant them protection, if any threat to their life and liberty is perceived. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law if any committed by them.
