Case has been listed today on account of mentioning made, since the same had been fixed for 02.07.2020. The matter has been taken up by way of Video Conferencing facility in view of COVID-19 situation, as per instructions issued.

In the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., the petitioner is seeking concession of regular bail in case FIR No.445 dated 11.12.2019 under Sections 177, 199, 200, 420, 465, 467, 468 and 471 IPC, registered at Police Station, Division No.5, Ludhiana.

The FIR has been lodged on instructions of the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana, as the petitioner had impersonated himself as Gurcharan Singh and furnished forged revenue record for the purpose of furnishing of bail bonds of one Sanjay Aggarwal, who had been ordered to be released on bail.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has been in custody since the date of his arrest i.e. 11.12.2019 and the investigation is complete

and the case is now fixed for framing of charge tomorrow i.e. 03.06.2020, considerable time is likely to be taken for conclusion of the Magisterial trial. State counsel also pointed out that no other case of similar nature is pending against the petitioner.

Accordingly, the present application for regular bail is allowed. The petitioner shall be released on regular bail on furnishing of bail bonds/sureties to the satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Ludhiana.
