This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of direction to respondents to take action against real culprits on the basis of representation dated 26.08.2019 and to investigate the matter impartially by the higher rank officer.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has already made representation dated 26.08.2019 to respondent No.3-Inspector General of Police, Border Range, Amritsar, District Amritsar, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/1, but still no action has been taken.
