Learned counsel for the applicant *inter alia* contends that impugned judgment of the trial court dismissing complaint of applicant is based on surmises and conjectures. Trial court failed to appreciate that respondent-accused has admitted his signatures on the cheque in question and that the same pertains to his bank account. Presumption under Section 139 of the Negotiable Instruments Act has not been drawn illegally in favour of applicant.
