AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

The application bearing CM-7308-CWP-2020 restraining the respondent No.3(Gram Panchayat) from dispossessing the petitioner from the land in dispute and demolishing their house.

Learned State counsel states that as per his instructions application under Rule 12 (4) of the Punjab Village Common Land (Regulation) Rules 1964 is pending with the Government.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of this statement he does not wish to press petition and he would be satisfied if the direction be given to the respondent not to take any coercive step against the petitioners till the decision of this application.

In the circumstances, with the consent of all the counsel main case is taken up on the board itself today and this petition stands disposed of with a direction that till such time as the application Rule 12 (4) of the Punjab Village Common Land (Regulation) Rules 1964 is not decided by the competent authority the petitioners will not be dispossessed from the property in dispute.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
