The grievance of the petitioner is that the State authorities are not taking any action upon his representation dated 20.6.2018 (Annexure P-3) and the reminder dated 15.4.2019 (Annexure P-4). These communications were addressed by the petitioner in relation to the disqualification allegedly suffered by the fourth respondent, who is holding the post of Sarpanch of the Gram Panchayat of Village Bir Dandhur, Tehsil and District Hisar, Haryana.

As the authorities are yet to apply their mind to the issue raised by the petitioner, this Court is not inclined to entertain this writ petition for adjudication on merits. Further, as this Court is not entering into the validity of the allegations levelled by the petitioner against the fourth respondent, no cause is made out to put the fourth respondent on notice or afford him an opportunity of hearing.

The writ petition is accordingly disposed of directing the Deputy Commissioner, Hisar, the third respondent, to take appropriate action upon the petitioner's communications, if warranted, in accordance

with law and due procedure.

This exercise shall be completed expeditiously and in any event, not later than eight weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
