This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case General Diary No. 40 dated 28.08.2019 registered under Sections 307, 336, 427, 148, 149 and 506 IPC 1860 and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act 1959 in case FIR No. 17 dated 26.08.2019 under Sections 307, 336, 427, 148, 149, 201 IPC 1860 and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act 1959 registered at Police Station Majitha Road Distt Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the present petitioner in General Diary No. 40 is that he has fired gun shot. However, he states that nobody was injured due to gun shot.

On specific query put to learned counsel for the State, he, on instructions from ASI Sakattar Singh, is not disputing the above fact. He has emailed custody certificate dated 12.08.2020. As per this custody certificate, the petitioner has been in custody for 10 months and 19 days. Charges are yet to be framed and next date before the trial Court is

19.08.2020.

Keeping in view that nobody was injured on account of firing gun shot by the petitioner and that the trial will take some time for its conclusion, this Court feels that there is no need to detain the petitioner any longer. Accordingly, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on bail to the satisfaction of the concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
