This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to mark enquiry of complaint to himself or some higher official or to some other police station or to constitute SIT so that fair and impartial enquiry may be conducted into the complaint of petitioners with further prayer to issue direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of petitioners and their family members at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5.

Learned counsel for petitioners contended that petitioners have already made representation dated 14.12.2019 to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala, District Batala, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/5, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Harbir Sandhu, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Complete copy of paperbook has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala, District Batala, to look into and decide representation dated 14.12.2019 (Annexure P/5) as expeditiously as possible and that too in accordance with law.
