Learned State counsel informs that the trial is at the advanced stage inasmuch as out of 11 prosecution witnesses cited by the prosecution, 07 of them have been examined and now the case is fixed for 30.03.2020 for remaining prosecution evidence.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he be permitted to withdraw the instant petition granting him liberty to raise all these pleas before the trial Court. Allowed.
