The case is taken up through video conferencing on account of COVID 2019.

Quashing of FIR No. 108 dated 15.8.2019 registered under Sections 109, 120 B, 313, 323, 352, 406, 498 A, 506, 509 IPC at Police Station Women Cell, Panchkula and report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. filed under Sections 323, 352, 406, 498 A, 506 IPC and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise has been sought.

Vide order dated 25.2.2020, parties were directed to appear before learned Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court concerned on 24.3.2020 for recording their statements and trial Court was to send its report regarding the genuineness of compromise.

Report of learned JMIC, Panchkula is received wherein it is stated that parties have made their statements as per their own free will and without any pressure and compromise is genuine and voluntarily.

In view thereof, this petition is allowed. FIR No. 108 dated 15.8.2019 registered under Sections 109, 120 B, 313, 323, 352, 406, 498 A, 506, 509 IPC at Police Station Women Cell, Panchkula and report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. filed

under Sections 323, 352, 406, 498 A, 506 IPC and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.

As per compromise, an amount of Rs. 5000000/- is to be paid by petitioners to respondent No. 2 on 20.11.2020 at the time when statement of parties is to be recorded with respect to second motion in the petition for divorce which is pending before Family Court, Panchkula.

Learned counsel for respondent No. 2 states that said statement is to be recorded on 20.11.2020 .

Learned counsel for petitioners undertakes that petitioners would appear before Family Court, Panchkula on 20.11.2020 for recording their statements.
