At the request of counsel for the parties, the hearing of the main writ petition is preponed to today from 19.01.2021 and taken on board.

Learned counsel for the respondents has informed the Court that the petitioner was very much aware of the fact that the vehicle, which has been surrendered by him on 17.11.2019, stands sold on 14.01.2020. The writ petition has been filed on 14.02.2020 without disclosing this fact. That apart, it is asserted that in the light of the fact that the vehicle stands already sold, the prayer made in the writ petition cannot be accepted at this stage.

What has been stated by counsel for the respondents is apparently correct and, therefore, we do not find any reason to interfere in the present writ petition.

The writ petition, therefore, stands dismissed.

Petitioner shall, however, be at liberty to avail of his alternative remedy in accordance with law, if permissible.

As the main writ petition stands dismissed, CM-12971-2020 is also dismissed as infructuous.
