The State Project Director, Haryana School Shiksha Pariyojna Parishad, Panchkula, issued advertisement dated 15.06.2019 for filling up 1207 posts of Assistant Block Resource Coordinators. As per advertisement the engagement was to be on contractual basis initially for a period of one year. 226 posts were reserved for the SC Category.

Petitioner belongs to the SC category and being eligible as per terms and conditions of the advertisement applied for the post.

Counsel has referred to the document at Annexure P-4 issued by the Board of School Education, Haryana, Bhiwani to assert that the petitioner has secured total 53.97 marks in the selection process.

The precise grievance raised in the petition is that as per result issued by the second respondent at Annexure P-6 the last candidate reflected as duly selected under the SC category has secured 53.8008 marks whereas the petitioner inspite of having secured higher marks i.e. 53.97 her name is not reflected in the select list.

Counsel submits that even a representation in such regard has been made and he would be satisfied if the writ petition were to be disposed of at this stage with direction to the competent authority to look into the matter.

Submission advanced by counsel is found to be just and reasonable.

Without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the writ petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the writ petition with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider the grievance of the petitioner against the backdrop of the representation dated 27.12.2019 (Annexure P-7) and to take a decision thereupon expeditiously and in any case within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Disposed of.
