The petitioners are some of the members of the Zila Parishad of District Yamuna Nagar, State of Haryana. Their grievance is that the authorities are not releasing grants in relation to development works, despite all necessity formalities having been completed. The petitioners seem to have submitted representation dated 03.01.2020 (Annexure P-3) in this regard to the Vice-Chairman of the Zila Parishad requesting that necessary steps be taken at the earliest so that development works are carried out.

Mr. Rajesh Gaur, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, was asked to ascertain as to whether the aforestated Annexure P-3 was received and if so, whether necessary funds have already been

sanctioned.

Today, Mr. Rajesh Gaur, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, would inform this Court that the matter was held up due to some differences between the past and the present Chair-persons of the Zila Parishad of District Yamuna Nagar and that steps are being taken to finalize the issue, so that funds are sanctioned for the development works to be undertaken. As it is for the authorities to decide as to what should be the development works to be undertaken by the Zila Parishad and to release the requisite amounts in accordance with due procedure, this Court sees no grounds to keep this writ petition pending for further adjudication.

The writ petition is accordingly disposed of directing the Chief Executive Officer, Zila Parishad, Yamuna Nagar District, the third respondent, to take appropriate action in this regard and ensure that the funds are released for undertaking the identified development works. Such sanction and release shall be undertaken expeditiously and in any event, not later than three weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
